

ISRO organized a closed-door interactive format workshop for early-stage space startups and aspiring space entrepreneurs. Scientists of ISRO gave a brief on various topics like Navigation & Communication, Geospatial Technologies, Aerospace Materials, Avionics/ Electronics, etc, and provided ideas for the development of new products and services in these fields. ISRO and Social Alpha signed an MoU to launch the Spacetech Innovation Network (SPIN), a platform for innovation, curation, and venture development of space startups. Director of ISpA Wg Cdr Satyam Kushwaha (Retd) participated as a guest speaker and gave a brief on the role of ISpA and how it will be helping new space startups.

BIF India SatCom 2022

India SatCom 2022, the 8th edition of Broadband India Forum's (BIF) annual flagship event was held in New Delhi on December 14-15, 2022. The event saw participation from other industry stalwarts, along with senior government dignitaries from ISRO, DoS, DoT, TRAI, NSIL as well as other leading government stakeholders. A BIF White Paper on 'Emerging trends in Satcom & Broadcasting' was released by the honourable dignitaries. This White Paper examines the emerging and new trends in the satellite technologies in the future and the important applications & use cases which will make it enter the mainstream and core of 5G and the 6G networks in delivering high-speed broadband and converged access (broadband & broadcasting) to users



In Other Updates



ITU-APT: Telecom Stories Read complete excerpt at itu-apt.org

Incumbent Telecom Carriers asked the government to identify and release a 6 GHz spectrum band for fifth-generation or 5G Services expansion. In a letter to the telecom secretary stating that the 6 GHz band will be the only key mid-band spectrum for 5G expansion to cater to the increasing demand from consumers and enterprises. In India, 6 GHz is partly used for satellite operations by the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) that a co-existence between 5G and other use cases is possible in the band basis of multiple studies, and added that the FS links which are limited to lower 6 GHz band (5925–6425 MHz) in India and deployed at known locations, national-level coordination is possible between IMT and FS.

Moon Monday #108: A lunarbound KPLO, many mission updates, future foundations, and more

- On December 17, the Korea Pathfinder Lunar Orbiter (KPLO) successfully entered lunar orbit, making it South Korea's first such spacecraft.
- The biological experiment onboard BioSentinel was turned on by the mission team on December 5 while the CubeSat was more than 1 million kilometers away from Earth.
- A few weeks ago, the LunaH-Map CubeSat successfully demonstrated autonomous optical navigation, an important ability for small satellites.
- Contact was lost with the CuSP CubeSat just an hour after deployment on Artemis I launch day, November 16, due to an unexplained spike in battery temperature.
- The Artemis I Orion capsule is now being returned to NASA's Kennedy Space Center to know exactly how well its heat shield worked during its fiery reentry into Earth's atmosphere.
- ispace Japan's first lunar lander, launched on December 11, successfully completed the first orbital maneuver using its propulsion system on December 15
- The launch of Russia's Luna 25 robotic Moon lander was delayed from earlier this year to 2023 because its Doppler distance and velocity sensors underperformed during testing.




